Subject: Hon'ble Prime Minister's Interaction with Students of schools (Pariksha Par Charcha) – reg.

With class X and class XII examinations round the corner, Hon'ble Prime Minister will interact with school students on 16th February 2018 with his initiative 'Pariksha Par Charcha' wherein he will advise the students on how to deal with examination stress. The timings of the programme will be 10.30 am to 12.00 noon.

Main Features of the Programme:

1. Students from classes VI onwards of all the schools can view or hear the telecast/broadcast.
2. It will be:
 - Broadcast live by Doordarshan through DD National, DD News and DD India.
 - Aired live on radio channels (All India Radio Medium Wave, All India Radio FM Channel)
 - Streamed live on websites of PMO, MHRD, Doordarshan, MyGov.in, YouTube channel of MHRD, Facebook Live.
 - Telecasted on Swayamprabha channels of MHRD
3. Hon'ble Prime Minister will answer questions of school students from class IX and above. Students may submit their questions on MyGov platform from 6th February, 2018 (1000hrs) to 11th February, 2018 (1200hrs). Only selected questions will be featured in the programme.

Instructions on posing questions:

1. Students only from class IX and above may ask a question.
2. The question should only be about handling the stress in schools caused due to studies/exams and how this can be handled.
3. The question should be direct and brief (not more than 100 words).
4. The questions should be in English or Hindi only.

All schools are requested to make necessary arrangements in the school to enable the students to view / hear the telecast/broadcast, through any one of the modes mentioned above.
